Path /Medicine Wheel Garden

There is a story that speaks of 4 brothers, one red, one white, one black and one yellow. As brothers do, they started to fight. The Creator separated them to distant parts of Mother Earth giving each one responsibility for one element. The Creator told them that in the future they would come back to live together.

Brothers and sisters from Pine Ridge to South Africa, from China to Washington DC will be sharing, learning and enjoying the Thunder Mountain Lenape' festival.

Follow the sign to the shaded path leading to the medicine wheel garden to hear this and other stories, to learn about the elements, crystals, stones, herbs and plants that make up the medicine wheel. Also learn how to use the medicine wheel in you daily living.
